Introduction

Undertaking the Diploma of Property Services is the next stage of an exciting career in Real Estate. It is a challenge that will assist you undertake a range of existing career pathways options in this industry.

The Diploma course has been structured into groups of complementary subjects studied through a mix of distance learning, coaching/mentoring plus your attendance and involvement in keynote lectures. You will be personally mentored by College staff to ensure that you are confident in your study. You need to meet with a College Mentor who will work with you to determine a training program that will personally suit your background and current work commitments. Most candidates ask HOW LONG will it take? The answer is that this varies in each case. This course is at the Diploma level and will require considerable effort by you to achieve your goals. This is not meant to deter you, but to assist you to focus on the skills that you will develop, rather than on the time that it will take.

Starting Dates and Mode of Study

The College offers a rolling intake, so you can begin the Diploma of Property Services (Agency Management) at any time. The course can be undertaken on a full or part-time basis.

Vocational Outcomes

Candidates completing this course may choose to operate as Real Estate Agents, Real Estate Office Principals or undertake the study solely for professional development. The Diploma of Property Services is the minimum educational requirement for registration as a Real Estate Agent in South Australia.

Prerequisites

School year 10 or equivalent. Candidates generally have completed the equivalent of the Certificate IV in Property Services (Real Estate).

Applicable Legislation

Land Agents Regulations 1995, under the Land Agents Act 1994 (South Australia).

Recognition of Prior Learning

Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL) recognises an individual's current knowledge and skills learned from other courses, life experience and/or workplace training, and measures it against the course they wish to do. If what has been learnt is relevant to the course, some parts of the course may not have to be completed.

Credit Transfer and Mutual Recognition

Credit Transfer means credit towards qualifications granted to students on the basis of outcomes gained by a student through participation in identical units of competency from courses or training packages with another Registered Training Organisation. Credit Transfer is available to any student enrolling in the Real Estate Training College.

Assessment

The Diploma is presented in a competency-based format and a candidate's competency will be assessed at all levels according to specified competencies and performance criteria. The training assessment is based on written assessments, questions and practical demonstrations of competency. You will complete a training plan

at induction with the College that is flexible and complements your work and personal timetable. Trainers will outline the specific assessment for each unit and further information will be discussed at your induction to the College.
